



Change to the Testing Method for J-CAT for Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University International Undergraduate Applications

On May 29, 2020, we announced in the document “Additional Accepted Japanese Language Proficiency Tests for Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University International Undergraduate Applications” that applicants who will take the J-CAT will receive further instructions for taking the test after the stage 1 results are announced. However, from July 8, 2020, we will change the timing of the announcement, and applicants will receive further instructions after the application deadline instead.

1. Testing Method Announcement

The timing of the announcement will be changed from after the stage 1 result notification to after the application deadline. APU will designate certain dates when applicants can take the J-CAT after the application deadline, and applicants will be able to choose the date they would like to take the test. APU will announce the available test dates by email after the application deadline.

2. Requesting to take the J-CAT

Within the APU Online Application System, please indicate that you will not be able to submit scores of either EJU or JLPT and that you would like to take the J-CAT.
