

Please only include activities from high school level grade 10 or above (or equivalent of high school level grade 10 or above).

*Only the official form designated by APU will be considered for assessment. Portfolios, CDs, DVDs, etc. created by the applicant will not be considered proof of extracurricular activities so please do not submit them. (These items will not be returned to you even if you do submit them.)

*Only regional, national and international extracurricular activities will be considered for assessment. Activities organized within the school other than student council leadership position, Model UN, etc. will not be considered so please do not list them.

Reapplying

Admitted applicants will not be allowed to reapply to the same college for the same enrollment period (April 2017 or September 2017 enrollment period). If an admitted applicant does reapply, a new interview will not be performed and results will not be given. The application fee will also not be returned.





APU Tuition Reduction Scholarship Application

Only individuals who will obtain a student visa before enrollment are eligible to apply for the APU Tuition Reduction Scholarship at the time of application. Those who would like to apply for the APU Tuition Reduction Scholarship must answer the following two questions after having read the paragraph below.

IMPORTANT

This scholarship is made available by the financial contributions of domestic and international companies and individuals, together with the Japanese Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT), that support the ideals of APU, and its purpose is to help reduce the financial burden for outstanding international students of lesser financial means. Students awarded with this scholarship are expected to maintain a good academic record, complete the tasks assigned to them and serve as role models for their country and regions.

A review of academic performance and other criteria will be conducted each semester to determine whether or not recipients qualify for renewal of the APU Tuition Reduction Scholarship. Provided that the recipients maintain a good academic record, complete the tasks assigned to them on time and avoid any misconduct unbefitting of a scholarship recipient, the scholarship will remain valid until the standard number of credits required to graduate has been reached. In cases of inappropriate behavior or conduct that tarnished the reputation of the University, the scholarship will be revoked. Interested applicants are to submit their scholarship application upon understanding of the above.





- (1) Purpose of Use of Personal Information

- (2) Management of Personal Information
