Admission fee (one-time deposit)

130,000 JPY (1,130 USD*)

Annual tuition

1,400,000 JPY (12,174 USD*)

This includes 49,000 JPY per month for housing, additional fees, and a typical amount spent on living costs such as food, books, transportation, etc.
