1. New Accepted Tests

- (1) Japanese Proficiency Test*(JPT) *This test is different from the JLPT.
- (2) Japanese Computerized Adaptive Test(J-CAT)

2. Applicants Who May Use These Tests

- International applicants residing outside Japan applying for April and September 2021 admissions.
- International applicants residing in Japan applying for April and September 2021 admissions.

3. Submission Method

- (1) JPT(Japanese Proficiency Test)

Upload a digital copy of the score report within your online application.

- (2) J-CAT(Japanese Computerized Adaptive Test)

Within the online application system, please inform us that you will not be able to submit scores of either EJU or JLPT and you would like to take the J-CAT. You will receive further instructions after you receive your stage 1 results.
